Only articles submitted through Journal Website (OJS) will be accepted. Articles should not exceed 25 pages of type script in MS Word on A4 size paper. Text fount of articles in English language should be 12 and references in 10. Urdu and Arabic language Articles fount 14 and references in 12. Articles themes fonts of English in "Times New Roman", Arabic in Sakkal Majallah and Urdu in Jameel Noori Nastaleeq fount. Full name of author along with professional affiliation / address, phone and e-mail address should be written on the manuscript. All submissions must include a 150-250 word abstract with five keywords, introduction, discussion, results, summery and conclusions. References must be as footnotes on the Chicago Style and it is can be seen at this link <u>Chicago Notes and Bibliography Style</u>. The following examples can also be followed:
